




Annual Report

During the year we have provided services to the community in various ways. The "Talent Search" was prestigious for the YMCA before the Nineties, and could not be continued due to the crisis in our country.

Later, it was restarted with the organizational support of the Uduvil Girls' College for some years and was stopped due to financial difficulties.

In 2017, the "Talent Search" has been restarted in collaboration with St.John's College and would be continued in the forthcoming years.

As to keep a close relationship with the Members, Birthday Cards are now being sent and a questioner was also forwarded to the members to obtain more details for updating the membership database.

The World YMCA celebrated the 174th Anniversary this year. Under the World Challenge Programme, the National Council of the YMCAs of Sri Lanka conducted a Motor Bike Parade with 60 Motorbikes riding to Jaffna from Mannar on 2nd June 2018. The Jaffna & Mannar YMCAs were the organizers. Many members of the brother YMCAs from all over the country joined at Mannar and came to Jaffna YMCA in a parade. A Motorbike Awareness Exhibition was conducted by the stunt riders of "YAMAHA" which brought mass publicity amongst the public.

The YMCA is continuing the community oriented services like Medical Health Care, Educational Support, Disaster Management etc...

The YMCA environment is now beautiful, with multicoloured croton and plants in and out of the YMCA premises. Two rooms of the Hostel have been facilitated with Attached Baths. A karate class is being conducted in the Main Hall every Saturday and Sunday on a rental basis.

The Directors gave attention to the YMCA Village, and visited: many occasions, where a Community Centre had been built and drinking water also provided from a common well situated at the lyakkachchi junction. The Preschool is functioning well, but the number of students are getting less. Through the support of the Divisional Secretariat, the family members enjoy a Housing Scheme, Toilets etc..

Preschool Teachers' Training:




