Annual Report

We are happy to present the Report for the period April 2015 – March 2016. To commemorate the 125th Anniversary, many programmes and activities were conducted even in other districts and it generated good publicity to the YMCA Jaffna. To enhance our activities the following new committees were appointed such as for Education, Human Resource and Vulnerable Community Service.

The Building was refurbished, repainted and thus now gives a good look at present. A new Office setup was created and it was declared opened by the President Mr.R.Vinoth on 19th August 2015.

As an improvement, a study was made on our present accounting practices to be on par with presentday mandatory accounting principles. This was done to highlight shortcomings and make the accounting more efficient and effective.

A deficit balance was shown in the Income Statement for the period April 2015 - March 2016. This was due to the expenditure on account of 125th Anniversary Celebrations.

We are very much proud to record that the Jaffna YMCA has been selected as the BEST YMCA for the year 2015 under the Presidentship of Mr.R.Vinoth. The Jaffna YMCA was previously adjudged as the Best YMCA for the year 2003 and 2004. The Annual General Meeting of 2016 of the National Council of the YMCAs of Sri Lanka was held at Jaffna YMCA and our President Mr.R.Vinoth elected as the youth Vice President.

Our past Presidents, Members and Staff who live abroad visited the YMCA during the year 2015. Many Presidents and General Secretaries and Members of the YMCAs in the country also attended the 125th Anniversary Celebrations and experienced our programmes and activities.

We also regret to note the demise of our former long standing Board of Director and President (2004/2005) Mr.S.P.Jeevanantham on 10.12.2015.

1. 125th Anniversary Celebrations - Chairman, Rev.V.Daniel Jeyaruban

The following programmes were conducted to commemorate our 125th Anniversary.

Members Get-together - Mr.T.Balasubramaniyam

To mark the 125th Anniversary Celebration, a Members Get-together was held on 18° July 2015 at the Auditorium. A PowerPoint presentation of Y activities and a Video Clip of the 18° World Youth Council were presented. A fellowship dinner followed after the activities.

Basketball Training Programme at Mannar - Mr.R.Vinoth

Under the 125th Anniversary Celebration activities, a Basketball Training Programme was conducted at Mannar. 50 Participants from various schools in Mannar attended. The Mannar YMCA organized the Programme, in concurrence with YMCA Jaffna.

Leadership Training Seminar at Vavuniya -Mr.R.Vinoth

As part of commemoration of the 125th Anniversary Celebration, a Leadership Training Seminar for School Prefects was held on 18th June 2015 at the Education Department, Vavuniya. Sixty students from nine schools participated. The subjects discussed were:- Child Protection by Mr.T.Selvakumar, Traffic Regulations by Traffic Policemen from the Vavuniya Police Station and Discipline and Leadership by Mr.K.Bernard Retired, Head College of Education. The Vavuniya YMCA organized the Seminar, in concurrence with YMCA Jaffna.

Thanksgiving Service - Rev.N.J.Gnanakarunyan

A Thanksgiving Service was conducted on 5th December 2015 at St. John the Baptist Church.

The message was delivered by Rt.Rev.Dr. Justin Bernard Gnanapragasam, the Bishop, Roman Catholic Church, Diocese of Jaffna. Members went on a procession to the Church from YMCA Jaffna.

Road race - Mr.T.Vimalraj

A Road race was held on 5th December 2015 at 6.00am starting at YMCA. 32 Youths participated. The St. John's Ambulance, Scout Group of St. John's College and the Traffic Police, Jaffna assisted in the race.

One the last day a Public Meeting was held (12th December 2016). Religious leaders of all denominations, Directors of the Member YMCAs, Higher Officials of the Government sector, Principals of Schools, Members and Well-wishers of YMCA Jaffna were invited to the meeting. The Preschool Christmas Programme was held on 02nd December 2015 at 9.00am. 82 children from three Preschools participated and each School performed many programmes. Christmas Gift packets for the year 2015 were offered to Children at Karunaniliyam Kilinochchi, Uduvil Girl's College, Nuffield School for Deaf and Blind, St John's College and Cheddikulam Mahavidyalayam.

Medical Work - Chairman, Mr.A.J.Kadirgamar Support at Udddapussellawa, Nuwaraeliya District

Further to an assignment, 120 Children from estate labour workforce were provided with a Raincoat by the YMCA on 31st July 2015 after a sporting event. The President Mr.R. Vinoth, Chairman Medical Work Mr.A.J.Kadirgamar, Board of Director Mr.M.Nishangan, General Secretary Mr.S.Jeyarajasingam, Volunteer Staff of Jaffna YMCA M/s. J.Jesuthasan and S.Gowry Shangar were present at the function. Rev.A. Thevathasan, Secretary of The Church of American Ceylon Mission (CACM) was the Chief Guest.

Medical Clinic to Elders

A Medical Clinic was held on 12th February 2016, with the assistance of the Pradeshiya Sabab, Nallur. More than forty elders benefited from the Clinic. Blood tests for Diabetics, Check-up for Blood Pressure were taken and necessary medication were prescribed free of charge.

Health Awareness Programme: A Television has been fixed at the Canteen and telecasting Health related videos, on the causes of Smoking, Drinking and Advice on Diabetes, Blood Pressure etc... The Television was officially switched on by Mr.T.C.Brownson, the NGS of NCY on 6th February 2016. Programme and activities of YMCA Jaffna also video-cast via the Television.

Support to Elders' Home

On a request made by the Christian Living Committee of the National Council of the YMCAs of Sri Lanka, a sum of Rs.10,000/= was donated to provide a Washing Machine to the Wilbert Perera, Elders' Home at Kaduwela.

Support to Nepal Earthquake Victims

An Earthquake hit Nepal, following the Quake, on 25th April 2015, the death toll amounted to nearly 7,000 and the number injured rose to more than 14,000, and 450,000 people were displaced.

The National Council of YMCAs of Sri Lanka made an appeal seeking assistance from Local YMCAs to help Nepal YMCA.

YMCA Jaffna gave a sum of Rs.10,000/- (to Nepal YMCA) towards the affected and vulnerable sections of the country due to the devastation.

Relief Work - Chairman, Mr.M.Nishangan Flood Relief

There was severe rains and strong winds in the North which affected many people in the middle of November 2015. 51,656 persons belonging to 13,556 families were displaced and sheltered in 53 Welfare Centers. 59 houses were fully damaged and 1071 were partly damaged, according to statistics provided.

In Jaffna District alone, 34,116 persons from 9,051 families were sheltered at Welfare Centers, (Common Halls, Schools, and Community Centers). 37 houses were fully damaged and 479 were partly damaged.

The Directors visited the Flood affected people at Poompukar Village (J/90). As an immediate relief, cooked meals (Lunch) were provided. Later, with the financial subsidy of the National Council of the YMCAs of Sri Lanka, a pack of a Mosquito Net, Mosquito Coils and a Mat were provided on 25° November 2015. 183 Families benefited from this project.

7. Elders' Work - Chairman, Mr.A.Donald

The Elders' Get-together:

The Elders' yearend get-together was held on 19th December 2015. 68 Elders participated at the gathering. Rs.800.00 worth of gift packets containing of Rice, Sugar, Tea, Milk Powder and Flour were presented to each Elder participant. Entertainment activities like Sing Songs, Parcel Passing, Musical Chairs etc... were conducted









and prizes were distributed to the winners. The Direct Family Financial Support - Canada (DFFSC) financially assisted towards the get-together.

8. Education-Chairman, Mr.R.Vinoth Study Materials

As a continuation of the Flood Relief, study materials worth Rs.510/= were distributed to the students on 5° March 2016. 114 students from Poompugar Village benefited. Mr.J.S.Mathuranayagam, Altorney At Law, was the Chief Guest at the function.

Financial Support

Around twenty five students from all over the island were financially assisted by the Direct Family Financial Support - Canada (DFFSC), once every three months through YMCA Jaffna for their studies.

9. Membership - Chairman, Mr.T.Balasubramaniyam Excursion - 2015

After a Charity Mission to Udapusellawa, the YMCA members went on an excursion on 1st August 2015. They visited important places in Nuwaraeliya, especially the Ambewela farm and had a river-bath. The members also visited the Kandy YMCA, Dalada Maligawa and the surrounding Kandy town.

Members, Staff & Family Get together

The Annual Get-together was held on 30° December 2015. Around forty five members and their families participated. Several entertainment activities were organized. A Fellowship Dinner followed, thereafter.

Excursion - 2016

Members and their family members and staff members participated at the excursion on 20th, 21st and 22th of February 2016. They visited Galle and Matara. In Matara, the members enjoyed visiting the Fort, Temples, Historical places and had a bath at the Polhena Beach. In Galle, the Martin Wicramasighe Museum, Fort, Harbor, Historical Places, Galle YMCA and Unawatuna Beach were visited. At Unawatuna Beach, on a Boating trip, sighted coral-rocks. Also on the way back to Jaffna, members stopped at Bentota. Mr.Nirmal De Fonsaka, the

present President of the National Council of the YMCAs of Sri Lana, assisted in finding a suitable accommodation and of the overview of the Galle Harbor. Members thank him for his support.

10. Hostel / Shops - Chairman, Mr.R. Vinoth

The Shopping Complex, Canteen and the ground floor shops were rented out and the Hostel is functioning as usual. Around 2041 people made use of our hostel during the reporting period.

An off-site Automated Teller Machine has been installed by the Union Bank at the Ground Floor of the Shopping Complex and it gives publicity to the YMCA Jaffna...

11.YMCA Village, lyakkachchi - Chairman, Mr.T.Jutharajah

The Board of Directors and 36 Youth members of Taichung YMCA Taiwan went to the YMCA Village Iyakkachchi on 25th August 2015 and indulged in a Shramadana Campaign, played with Preschool Children and planted Coconut Trees.

Survey

Arrangements are being made, to plot the land, as the land as the markings have been demolished during the crisis period and the original plan of the land also lost.

A Fence was done around the Preschool for the safety of Preschool Children with pillars barbed wire and Palmyra leave stalks.
