எங்களில் ஒருவராகி (மனுவுருவான இயேசு), வரலாற்றில் வாழ்ந்த இயேசுவின் முன்னெடுப்பு இறையாட்சி (மாற்கு 1:14,15). இறையாட்சியை பறைசாற்றியது மட்டுமல்ல, இறையாட்சியின் பண்புகளை மையமாக்கி வாழ்ந்ததால் சிலுவைச்சாவை எதிர்கொள்ள வேண்டியிருந்தது. இயேசுவின் முன்னெடுப்பை (நற்செய்தி) தொடருவது அவருடைய சீடர்களின் கடமை.

யதார்த்தத்தில் இரையாட்சி நோக்கிய அன்பாக்கம்:

நிலவும் சமூக அரசியல் பொருளாதார சமய கலாசார... யதார்த்தத்தில் நற்செய்தியாக்கத்தில், இயேசுவைப்போல (லூக்கா 4:18,19), ஈடுபடுவது இடைநிறுத்தப்படாமல் தொடரந்து நடைபெற வேண்டும். இயேசுவின் சீடர்களால் முன்னெடுக்கப்படும் அன்பு மைய வாழ்க்கைமுறை இறையாட்சி கருத்துருவாக்கத்தின் கட்டமைப்பாக இயல்பாக இருப்பதும் வளர்வதும் தொடரும்போதே நற்செய்தியாக்கம் உறுதியாக காணப்படும். ('நீங்கள் ஒருவருக்கொருவர் அன்பு செலுத்துங்கள்' என்னும் புதிய கட்டளையை நான் உங்களுக்குக் கொடுக்கிறேன். நான் உங்களுக்கு அன்பு செலுத்தியதுபோல நீங்களும் ஒருவருக்கொருவர் அன்பு செலுத்துங்கள். நீங்கள் ஒருவருக்கொருவர் செலுத்தும் அன்பிலிருந்து நீங்கள் என் சீடர்கள் என்பதை எல்லாரும் அறிந்துகொள்வர்'' என்றார் - யோவான் 13:34, 35).

இரையாட்சி நோக்கிய, அன்பாக்க வாழ்வும் பணியும், இயேசுவை பின்பற்றுவோரால் (திருஅவை, நிறுவனங்கள், அடிப்படை கிறிஸ்தவ சமூகங்கள், தனிப்பட்டோர்...) இன்று உண்மையாக முன்னெடுக்கப்படுகின்றதா? இயேசுவின் முன்னெடுப்பை உயிர்ப்புடன் தொடர இன்று எதிர்நோக்கப்படும் சவால்கள் என்ன, அவற்றை எப்படி கையாளலாம் என்பதை நோக்கி ஒரு முழுமையான மாற்றத்துக்காக செயற்படுவதும் சிந்திப்பதும் தடைப்படாமல் தொடர வேண்டும்.

இரையாட்சி நோக்கிய அன்பாக்கம் - ஒரு நோக்கு:

"போரினால் பாதிக்கப்பட்ட, இனஅழிப்புக்குள்ளாக்கப்பட்ட சூழ்நிலையில், எப்படிப்பட்ட 'செயற்பாடு – சிந்தனை – செயற்பாடு (ஈடுபாடு)' முன்னெடுக்கப்படவேண்டும்?'' என்பதை நோக்குவது, பற்றுறுதியுடன் வாழும் இயேசு சமூகத்தின் கடமை. ஆனால் யதார்த்தத்தில் எத்தகைய முன்னெடுப்புகள் மேற்கொள்ளப்படுகின்றன?

இராணுவ பிரசன்னத்துக்கு மத்தியில், போர் நடைபெற்றுக்கொண்டிருந்த, ஒரு குறிப்பிட்ட வரலாற்று காலகட்டத்தில் நிகழ்ந்துள்ள பேரவலத்தை, மனித உரிமைகள் மீறலை, மனுக்குலத்துக்கு எதிரான குற்றத்தை, இனவழிப்பை, 'செம்மணி மனித புதைகுழி' சுட்டிக்காட்டுகின்றது. இது நடைபெற்ற காலத்தில் ஆட்சியிலிருந்த அரசு மட்டுமல்ல அதனைத்தொடர்ந்து இன்று ஆளும் அரசும் முறையான பொறுப்புக்கூறவை செய்யவேண்டியது அவசியம்.

நடைபெற்ற போருக்கு காரணமான இனப்பிரச்சினை தீர்க்கப்படாமல், போரினால் ஏற்பட்ட பிரச்சினைகள் (காணால் ஆக்கப்பட்டோர், அரசியல் கைதிகள்...) இன்று அதிகரித்து வருகின்றன. இவை கவனத்திற்கொள்ளப்படாமல், இருப்பது பொருளாதாரப்பிரச்சினை இனப்பிரச்சினை அல்ல என கூறும் சிலருடைய போக்கு கேள்விக்குள்ளாக்கப்படவேண்டும்.

மன்னார் காற்றாலை மின் உற்பத்தி திட்டத்துக்கு எதிரான போராட்டம், முத்தையன்கட்டு இராணுவ முகாமிற்கு அழைத்துச் செல்லப்பட்ட திரு. கபில்ராஜ் எனும் இளைஞர், முத்தையன்கட்டு குளத்தில் சடலமாக மீட்கப்பட்டுள்ளமை தொடர்பாக நடைபெறும் எதிர்ப்பு நடவடிக்கைகள் உட்பட பல விடயங்கள் மனித நேயத்துடன் நோக்கப்படுகின்றனவா?

இந்த யதார்த்த விடயங்களை கையாளாமல் வெறும் வழிபாட்டுகளுடனும் கொண்டாட்டங்களுடனும் இயேசுவை பின்பற்றுவோர் அதிகமாக ஈடுபடமுனைவதால் குழப்பங்களும் துன்பங்களும் மட்டுமே தொடரும்.



Twynam joined the Ceylon Civil Service in 1845, served as Government Agent in Jaffna starting 1869, and held public office for approximately 27 years, retiring in 1896. He earned enduring respect, often referred to as the "Rajah of the North" for his firm and conscientious governance.

• Continued Public Service Post-Retirement Even after retirement, he remained an active resident and public figure in Jaffna until his death on March 12, 1922, at the age of ninety-four.
